How to use AmazonSmile on a web browser:

- 1. Visit smile.amazon.com
- 2. Sign in with the same account you use for Amazon.com
- 3. Select "DACOR Bacon House Foundation" as your favorite charity
- 4. Start shopping using the QR link below that will send items directly to Ukraine.
- 5. Remember to checkout at smile.amazon.com to generate 0.5% of your purchases as donations to DACOR Bacon House Foundation going forward.

How to use AmazonSmile using the Amazon app on your mobile phone:

1. Open the Amazon Shopping app

- 2. Navigate to the main menu (=)
- 3. Tap on Settings and then select "AmazonSmile"
- 4. Select your charity and then follow the on-screen instructions to turn ON AmazonSmile in the mobile app
- 5. Once AmazonSmile has been activated in your app, future eligible app purchases will generate a donation for the charity you have selected.

Local DC-area DACORians can drop off their own physical items at multiple locations in the DC area. The Ukrainian Diaspora in Washington DC in partnership with St. Andrews Ukrainian Orthodox Church and is collecting in-kind donations of clothing, non-perishable food, medical supplies, etc. to make regular shipments directly to Ukraine in partnership with the international shipping company MEEST.

Especially Needed Items You Might have on Hand in order of preference

· Non-perishable food – BIG DEMAND

- · Clothes and footwear for men/women/children
- · Thermal underwear
- · Hygiene products (women's products, diapers, etc.)
- · Blankets
- · Bedding
- · Table wear (disposable)
- · First aid and first aid kits
- · Tents, mattresses, sleeping bags
- · Standalone lamps
- · Candles
- · EMPTY 10-20 liter containers for liquids (suitable for water, fuel, mechanical lubricants)
